"Citron" is the story of observing a creature telescopically. A being that is curious, naive, strange, yet familiar. It sets out to discover the known whilst getting caught in the unknown - living grand adventures on the smallest of scales. "Citron" is a meeting, a meteorite crash, a metamorphosis of beings. Human beings included: those that love their own stories so much they forget their fictitious invention.

With the force of simplicity, CITRON takes us ton an infinitely small universe, where laughter is born, where we can marvel in wonderment.

INTENTION NOTE

The character is a pastiche of different animals and insects. Passing from puppy to pussycat, from sparrow to spider, sometimes even an abstract creature, it travels through different behaviours, emotions, and forms. A tribute to weavers, hole-diggers, hunters, to those who play, and all living beings who move and make constantly, to our fascination.

The character discovers its life, body, and space, becoming slowly conscience of his limitations that separate it from the world as a puppet on a table. Passing from joy to discovering solitude; fear of curiosity to to befriending cruelty, it collects a palette of emotional states whilst painting a self portrait of humanity.

In a journey that blurs the lines of imagined reality, Citron looks for a traveling companion until it loses its mind. The power of creation, imagination, the desire to both love and share are displayed through different dimensions of play. Whether a true exchange, or an imagined one, the possibility to be moved by what we think we see questions our relationship to our realities.



WHAT DOES MAKES US ALIVE ?

This performance is a bit of research into the essential. Wanting to focus on the foundations of puppetry, we sought out precision, detail, and especially childlike animism; the simple joy of play that gives the illusion of life. We opened our research to sincere cause-and-effect emotions to create a truthful piece full of life. We became thematically entrenched in discovery, life, and also death.

Close to imaginary of short animated films, this piece borrows from clown, puppetry, object theatre, physical theatre, and music.

This show dares to be told without text, travelling through the eyes and directly into the heart without bothering to stop by the brain, with lots of absurdity, tenderness, and humour. Created for small gauge, it invites us on an ephemeral voyage, a moment suspended in time.

Tired of sitting in the same chair every day he quit his job to travel the world on his bicycle. Through his journey he met, by surprise, his clown: a bit awkward, offbeat, quirky guy. It was clear he was not really from here, fascinated by new encounters, in constant discovery of the world that surrounds him, perplexed by the nature of things. Enamoured they decided to travel together.

Comedian, clown, and musician, Olmos studies theatre in Bruxelles, at the International School of Physical

Theatre Lassad, then moved to the clown school Le Samovar in Paris where he graduated in 2016. Since, Daniel has been working with many different companies and he also teaches comedians and clowns looking to better their craft.
